Department of Statistics (DOS): Agricultural Producers Price Index Increased by 5.7% During the First Eleven Months of 2025

The Department of Statistics (DOS) issued its monthly report for the year 2025 on the Agricultural Producers Price Index (APPI), which recorded an increase in the prices of agricultural producers by 5.7% in the first eleven months of 2025 compared to the same period in 2024, a decrease in November 2025 by (5.5%) compared to November 2024, and a decrease by (1.1%) compared to October 2025.

Accordingly, the cumulative APPI for the first eleven months of 2025 has reached 115.7 compared to 109.5 for the same period in 2024. Additionally, the APPI of November 2025 recorded 115.5 compared to 122.1 in November 2024 and 116.8 in October 2025.


Comparing the first eleven months of 2025 with the same period in 2024, prices for several crops have increased with a relative importance of 31.2%, most notably: Bananas by 23.2%, Chili Peppers by 19.2%, and Green Sweet Peppers by 15.5%. Meanwhile, the price index witnessed a decrease in the prices of several crops with a relative importance of (68.8%), most notably: Potatoes by (39.3%), Colored Sweet Peppers by (21.2%), and Eggplants by (15.3%).

The APPI of November 2025 has decreased compared to November 2024 due to the decrease in the price index of several crops with a relative importance of (39.7%), most notably: Potatoes by (70.5%), Green Maize by (57.3%), and Squash by (55.6%). In contrast, the price index of several crops has increased with a relative importance of 60.3%, most notably: Lemon by 202.4%, Papayas by 147.8%, and Olives by 46.2%.

Comparing the APPI of November 2025 to October 2025, the prices of several crops decreased with a relative importance of (85.4%), most notably: Tomatoes by (68.3%), Squash by (51.2%), Broccoli by (51.0%). Meanwhile, the price index of several crops has increased with a relative importance of 14.6%, most notably: Dates by 48.2%, Strawberries by 18.4%, and Eggplants by 11.4%.

The following graph illustrates the Agricultural Producers Prices during by Jordanian Qirsh for the main crops during the first eleven months of 2025.

It is worth mentioning that DOS has revised the methodology of collecting data on agricultural prices through a specialized technical committee from DOS and the Ministry of Agriculture. This revision was based on the recommendations of the *Permanent Experts Committee for Agricultural Statistics*, which is part of the National Agricultural Strategy. To improve data quality, agricultural price data for all crops have been sourced from the central markets on a monthly basis. The year 2016 was adopted as the base year (2016=100), and the *Laspeyres Equation* was used to compute the index.
