Department of Statistics: Producers Price Index (PPI) Decreased by (0.48 %) for the First Ten Months of 2024

The Department of Statistics (DOS) issued its monthly report on Producers Price Index (PPI) which observed a decrease by (0.48%) compared to the same period of 2023, a decrease in October 2024 by (2.11%) compared to the same month of 2023, and a decrease by (1.28%) compared to September 2024. Noting that the base year was amended to become (100=2018) instead of (100=2010).

Thus, the PPI of the first ten months of 2024 had reached 107.27 against 107.79 for the same period of 2023, and the PPI of October 2024 reached 106.12 against 108.42 for the same month of 2023, while the PPI of October 2024 reached 106.12 against 107.50 compared to September 2024.

Comparing the accumulative PPI for the ten months of 2024 with the same period in 2023, there were decreases in the prices of "Manufacturing Industries" by (0.61%) with a relative importance 88.74% and the prices of "Quarrying Industries" by (2.59%) with a relative importance 5.36%, while the prices of "Electricity" increased by 3.39% which represents a relative importance of 5.91%.

On the commodities level, the main commodities groups that contributed to decrease the PPI of October 2024 compared to the same month of 2023 were the decreases in the prices of Manufacturing Industries by (2.18%) with a relative importance of 88.74%, the prices the prices of Quarrying Industries by (0.77%) with a relative importance of 5.36%, and the prices of Electricity by (2.32%) with a relative importance of 5.91%.

On the monthly change domain, the PPI for October 2024 was decreased compared to September 2024 as a result of the decrease in the prices of "Manufacturing Industries" by (1.04%) with a relative importance 88.74% and the prices of "Quarrying Industries" by

(6.72%) with a relative importance 5.36%, while there was an increase in the prices of "Electricity" by 0.14% with a relative importance of 5.91%.
