Department of Statistics: Industrial Production Index Increased by 1.76% in the first eight months of 2025

The Department of Statistics issued its monthly report on the Industrial Production Index (IPI), which recorded an increase of 1.76% during the first eight months of 2025 compared to the same period in 2024. On a monthly basis, the IPI recorded an increase of 2.07% in August 2025 compared to August 2024, and a 1.03% increase compared to July 2025. Note that the base year has been modified to (2018=100) instead of (2010=100).




Figure 1: Monthly IPI for the years 2024 and 2025

Accordingly, the IPI for the first eight months of 2025 reached 88.90 compared to 87.36 for the same period in 2024. On a monthly level, the IPI for August 2025 reached 92.78 percentage points compared to 90.89 for August 2024. Additionally, the IPI for August 2025 reached 92.78 compared to 91.83 in July 2025.

Comparing the cumulative IPI for the first eight months of 2025 to the same period in 2024, there were increases in the production quantities of the "Manufacturing Industries" sector by 1.81% with a relative importance of 88.7% and the quantities of "Electricity Production" by 3.22% with a relative importance of 5.9%. Meanwhile, the production quantities of the "Quarrying Industries" sector decreased by (1.39%) with a relative importance of 5.4%.

On the monthly change domain, the IPI of August 2025 compared to the same month of 2024 has increased due to the increases in the production quantities of the "Manufacturing Industries" sector by 1.79% with a relative importance of 88.7%, the production quantities of the "Quarrying Industries" sector by 0.42% with a relative importance of 5.4%, and the production quantities of the "Electricity" sector by 7.99% with a relative importance of 5.9%.

On the sectorial level and by comparing the IPI of August 2025 with the IPI of July 2025, there were increases in the production quantities of the "Manufacturing Industries" sector by 0.67% with a relative importance of 88.7%, the production quantities of the "Quarrying Industries" sector by 1.67% with a relative importance of 5.4%, and the production quantities of the "Electricity" sector by 6.02% with a relative importance of 5.9%.
