Industrial Production Index Increased by 1.10 % in 2024

The Department of Statistics issued its monthly report on the Industrial Production Index (IPI), which observed an increase by 1.10 % in 2024 compared to 2023, and an increase by 4.67% in December 2024 compared to its counterpart in 2023. The report also showed an increase by 0.87% in December 2024 compared to November 2024, noting that the base year was amended to be (2018=100) instead of (2010=100).

Thus, the IPI of 2024 had reached 87.70 percentage points against 86.74 in 2023. Also, the IPI of December 2024 recorded 88.47 against 84.53 in December 2023, while the IPI of December 2024 recorded 88.47 against 87.71 in November 2024.

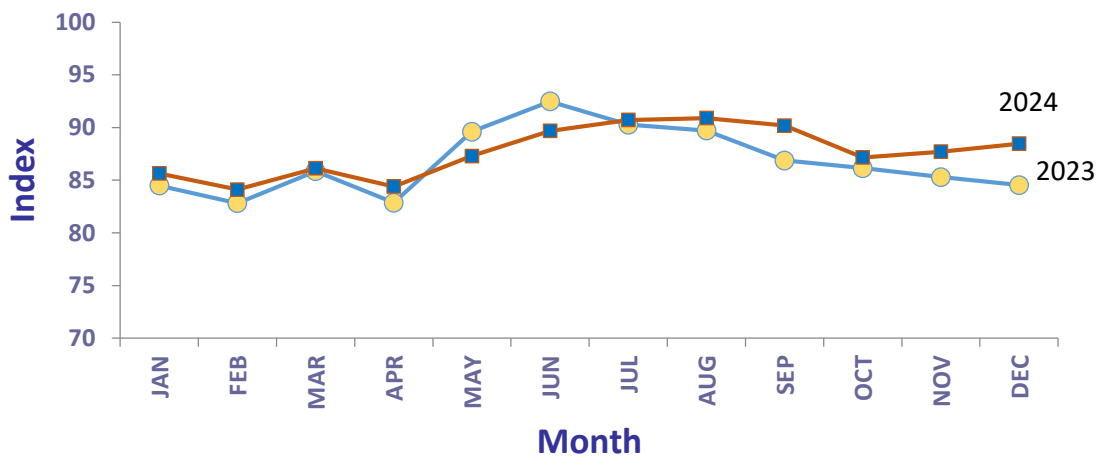
Comparing the accumulative IPI for 2024 with IPI of 2023, there were increases in the production quantities of the “Manufacturing Industries” by 0.45% with a relative importance of 88.7%, the “Quarrying Industries” by 7.31% with a relative importance of 5.4%, and the “Electricity Industry” by 5.83% with a relative importance of 5.9%.

On the domain of the monthly change, there was an increase in the IPI of December 2024 compared to the same month of 2023 due to the increases in the production quantities of “Manufacturing Industries” by 4.59% with a relative importance of 88.7%, “Quarrying Industries” by 0.06% with a relative importance of 5.4%, and “Electricity Industry” by 10.24% with a relative importance of 5.9%.

On the industry level and by comparing the IPI of December 2024 with November 2024, there were increases in the production quantities of the “Manufacturing Industries” by 0.11% with a relative importance of 88.7% and the “Electricity Industry” by 17.12% with

a relative importance of 5.9%, while there was a decrease in the production quantities of the “Quarrying Industries” by (3.03%) with a relative importance of 5.4%.
