Industrial Production Index Increased by 2.07% in the first five months of 2025

The Department of Statistics issued its monthly report on the Industrial Production Index (IPI), which recorded an increase during the first five months of 2025 by 2.07% compared to the same period in 2024. On the monthly level, the IPI has increased by 0.74% in May 2025 compared to the same month in 2024, and an increase by 2.95% compared to April 2025. Note that the base year has been modified to (2018=100) instead of (2010=100).

Accordingly, the IPI for the first five months of 2025 has reached 87.29 against 85.52 for the same period in 2024. On the monthly level, the IPI of May 2025 has reached 87.95 percentage points against 87.30 for the same period in 2024, while the IPI of May 2025 has reached 87.95 against 85.43 in April 2025.

Comparing the accumulative IPI for first five months of 2025 to the same period in 2024, there were increases in the production quantities of the "Manufacturing Industries" sector by 2.09% with a relative importance of 88.7% and the quantities of "Electricity Production" by 5.97% with a relative importance of 5.9%. Meanwhile, the production quantities of "Quarrying Industries" sector decreased by (3.48%) with a relative importance of 5.4%.

On the monthly change domain, the IPI of May 2025 has increased compared to the same month of 2024 due to the increase in the production quantities of the "Quarrying Industries" sector by 10.93% with a relative importance of 5.4%. and the production quantities of "Electricity" sector by 8.26% with a relative importance of 5.9%. Meanwhile, the production quantities of "Manufacturing Industries" sector decreased by (0.32%) with a relative importance of 88.7%.

On the sectorial level and by comparing the IPI of May 2025 with the IPI of April 2025, there were increases in the production quantities of the "Manufacturing Industries" sector by 2.12% with a relative importance of 88.7%, the production quantities of the "Quarrying Industries" sector by 11.42% with a relative importance of 5.4%, the production quantities of the "Electricity" sector by 8.24% with a relative importance of 5.9%.
