The Producer Price Index decreased by (0.27%) In the First Third of 2025

The Department of Statistics has released its monthly report on the Producer Price Index (PPI), which recorded a slight decrease of (0.27%) in the first third of 2025 compared to same period in 2024. On a monthly level, PPI decreased by (0.75%) in April compared to the same month of 2024, and by (0.57%) compared to the previous month of the same year. It is worth noting that the base year has been updated to **(2018=100)** instead of **(2010=100)**.

Accordingly, the Price index for the first third of 2025 reached 106.97 against 107.26 for the same period in 2024. On a monthly level, the index for April 2025 recorded 106.60, compared to 107.41 for the same month in 2024. The PPI for April 2025 also reached 106.60, compared to 107.21 in the previous month of the same year.

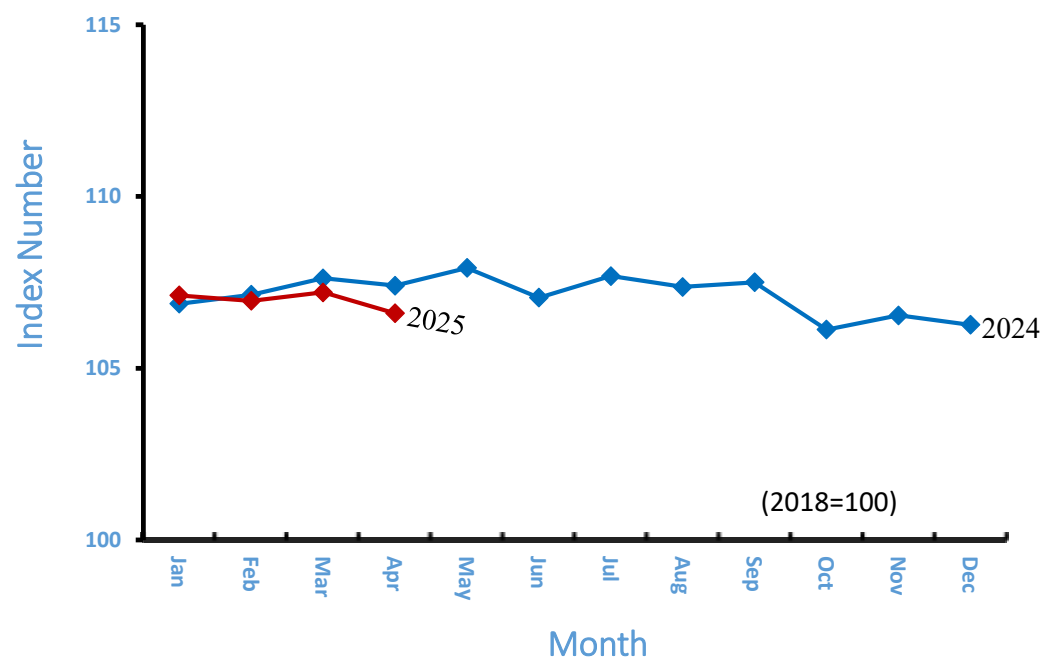
By comparing the cumulative PPI for the first third of 2025 with the same period in 2024, prices of “Manufacturing Industries” decreased by (0.23%), with a relative importance of 88.74%. Prices of “Quarrying Industries” also decreased by (1.33%), with a relative importance of 5.36%, while prices of “Electricity” increased by 0.18%, with a relative importance of 5.91%.

On the commodity level, the decrease in the index for April 2025 compared to the same month in 2024 was primarily driven by the decrease in the prices of “Manufacturing Industries” by (0.94%), with a relative importance of 88.74%, while the prices of “Quarrying Industries” increased by 0.49%, with a relative importance of 5.36%, and the prices of “Electricity” increased by 1.02%, with a relative importance of 5.91%.

In terms of the monthly change, the PPI for April 2025 decreased compared to the previous month of March 2025 as a result of the decrease in the prices of “Manufacturing Industries” by (0.66%) with a relative importance of 88.74%. Meanwhile the prices of “Quarrying Industries”

increased by 0.04%, with a relative importance of 5.36% and the prices of “Electricity” by 0.24%, with a relative importance of 5.91%.
