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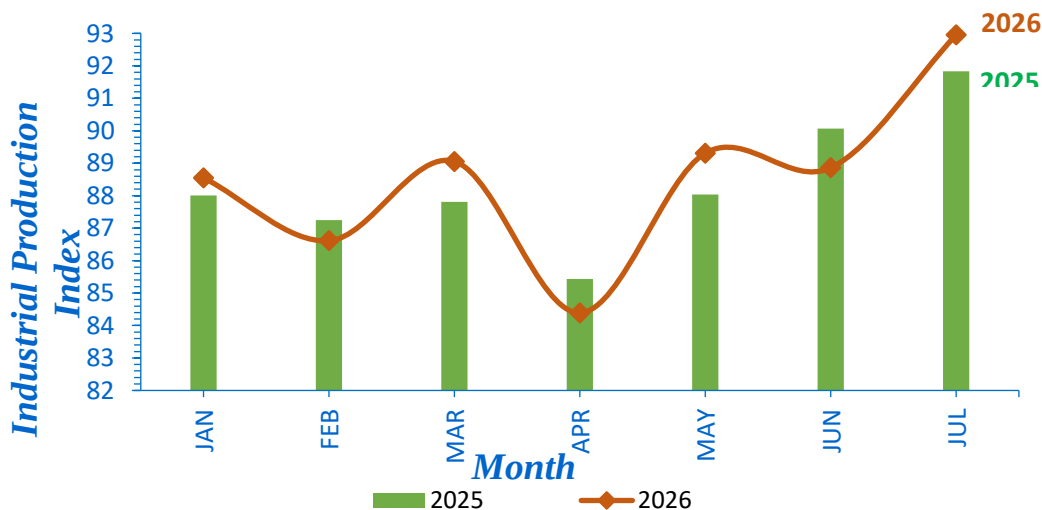
The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan

Department of Statistics:

- ***Industrial Production Quantities for the First Seven Months of 2026 Increased by 0.21%***
- ***Industrial production Quantities for July 2026 Increased by 1.22% compared to July 2025***
- ***Industrial production Quantities for July 2026 Increased by 4.61% compared to June 2026***

The Department of Statistics released its monthly report on the Industrial Production Index (IPI), which recorded an increase of 0.21% during the first seven months of 2026 compared to the same period of 2025. On the cumulative level, the IPI of July 2026 had increased by 1.22% compared to July 2025, and an increase of 4.61% compared to June 2026.

Accordingly, the IPI for the first seven months of 2026 had reached 88.53 against 88.35 during the same period of 2025. On a monthly basis, the IPI of July 2026 reached 92.96 percentage points against 91.83 in July 2025. Also, the IPI of July 2026 reached 92.96 against 88.86 in June 2026.

Comparing the cumulative IPI for the first seven months of 2026 with the same period of 2025, there were increases in the production quantities of “*Manufacturing Industries*” sector by 0.27%, with a relative importance of 88.7% and the “*Electricity*” sector by 1.90%, with a relative importance of 5.9%. Meanwhile, the production quantities of the “*Quarrying Industries*” sector decreased by (2.11%), with a relative importance of 5.4%.

On the monthly change domain, the IPI of July 2026 increased as compared to the same month in 2025 due to a 2.01% increase in the production quantities of the “*Manufacturing Industries*” sector, with a relative importance of 88.7%, and a 0.02% increase in the production quantities of the “*Electricity*” sector, with a relative importance of 5.9%. Meanwhile, there was decreases in the production quantities of the “*Quarrying Industries*” sector by (9.76%), with a relative importance of 5.4%.

One the sectoral level and by comparing the IPI of July 2026 with June 2026, there were increases in the production quantities of the “*Manufacturing sector*” by 4.29, with a relative importance of 88.7%, and in the “*Electricity Sector*” by 17.06%, with a relative importance of 5.9%. Meanwhile, the production quantities of “*Quarrying Industries*” had decreased by (2.79%), with a relative importance of 5.4%.
