Department of Statistics: Consumer Price Index (CPI) Increased by 1.92% in July 2024

The Department of Statistics issued its monthly report on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for July 2024 which observed an increase by 1.92% compared to the same month of 2023, and a slight increase by 0.24% (less than one percentage point) compared to June 2024. On the accumulative level, the CPI for the first seven months of 2024 has increased by 1.70% compared to the same period in 2023.

Thus, the CPI of July 2024 has reached 111.00 percentage points against 108.91 for the same month of 2023, while the CPI of July 2024 reached 111.00 against 110.74 for June 2024. On the accumulative level, the CPI for the first seven months of 2024 has reached 110.45 compared to 108.60 for the same period in 2023.

The increase in the CPI for July 2024 compared to the same month in 2023 was mainly driven by the following groups: the "Personal effects" group by 11.81%, "Vegetables and dry and canned legumes" group by 9.88%, "Water and Sanitation" group by 7.34%, "fruits and nuts" group by 7.18% and "Contribution to Unions" group by 5.86%. Conversely, the increase was mitigated by the following groups: "Oils and fats" group with a decrease by (2.08%), "Furniture, Carpets and linens" group by (1.69%), "Clothing" group by (1.58%) and "Household Textiles" group by (1.36%).

By Comparing the accumulative CPI for the first seven months of 2024 with the same period in 2023, the index increased for the following groups: "Personal effects" by 8.88%, "Water and Sanitation" by 7.34%, "Contribution to Unions" by 5.86%, "Rents" by 3.97%, and "Vegetables and dried and canned legumes" by 3.96%.

Among the most significant commodity groups that contributed to the increase in the CPI for July 2024 compared to the previous month of June were: "Vegetables and dried and canned legumes" with a 9.39% increase, "Personal luggage" by 1.33%, "Fruits and nuts" by 1.25%, "Spices and food additives, other food" by 0.69%, and "Culture and entertainment" with a 0.58% increase.




Figure 1: CPI fpr 2023 and 2024
