### **Department of Statistics: Consumer Price Index (Inflation) increased by 1.94% in the first seven months of 2025**

The Department of Statistics issued its monthly report on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) (Inflation), which observed an increase by 1.94% during the first seven months of 2025 compared to the same period in 2024. On the monthly level, the CPI of July 2025 increased by 1.68% compared to the same month of 2024, and decreased slightly by (0.10%) (less than one percentage point) compared to June 2025.

Thus, the CPI of the first seven months of 2025 had reached 112.59 against 110.45 for the same period of 2024. On the monthly level, the CPI of July 2025 had reached 112.87 against 111.00 in the same month of 2024, and the CPI of July 2025 had reached 112.87 against 112.98 in June 2025.

Comparing the commodity groups for the first seven months of 2025 to the same period of 2024, there were increases in the CPI of the "Personal Effects" group by 20.32%, "Tobacco and Cigarettes" by 12.60%, "fruits and nuts" group by 8.46%, "Tea, coffee, and cocoa" by 7.95%, and "Spices, food additives and other food" by 5.30%. Meanwhile, the CPI for the "Furniture, rugs, and bedding" group decreased by (2.92%), "House appliances" by (2.70%), "Fish and seafood products" by (1.90%), and "Dried and canned vegetables and legumes" by (1.70%).

At the commodity group level, the main groups that contributed to the increase in the CPI of July 2025 compared to July 2024 the "Personal Effects" group, "Tobacco and cigarettes", "Tea, coffee, and cocoa", "Fruits and nuts", and "Spices, food additives and, other food", while the main groups the contributed in decreasing the CPI were the "Dried

and canned vegetables and legumes” group, “Household appliances”, “Fish and seafood products”, and “Furniture, rugs, and bedding” group.

Tables (1) and (2) demonstrate the accumulative and monthly relative change.



Among the most prominent commodity groups that contributed to the decrease in the CPI of July 2025 compared to June of the same year were the "Meat and Poultry" by (4.13%),

“Fruits and Nuts” by (2.23%), “Dried and canned vegetables and legumes” by (1.71%), “Fish and sea products” by (0.41%), and “Beverage and refreshments” by (0.19%).
