Department of Statistics: Industrial Production Quantities Grew by 0.62% in January 2026


The Department of Statistics released its monthly report on the Industrial Production Index (IPI), which showed a 0.62% IPI increase in January 2026 compared to the same period in 2025, and a (0.25%) IPI decrease in January 2026 compared to December 2025.

The IPI of January 2026 reached 88.55 compared to 88.0 for the same period in 2025, and 88.78 in January 2025.

The recorded increase in the IPI of January 2026 compared to the same month of 2025 was due to the increase in the production quantities of the *Quarrying Industries* sector by 6.99%, with a relative importance of 5.4%, and the quantities of *Electricity* sector by 8.62%, with a relative importance of 5.9%. Meanwhile, the production quantities of the *Manufacturing Industries* sector decreased by (0.26%), with a relative importance of 88.7%.

Comparing to the IPI of December 2025, the decline in the IPI of January 2026 was due to the decrease in the production quantities of the *Manufacturing Industries* by (1.11%), and due to the increase in the production quantities of the *Quarrying Industries* sector by 6.45% and the quantities of *Electricity* sector by 7.09%.
