



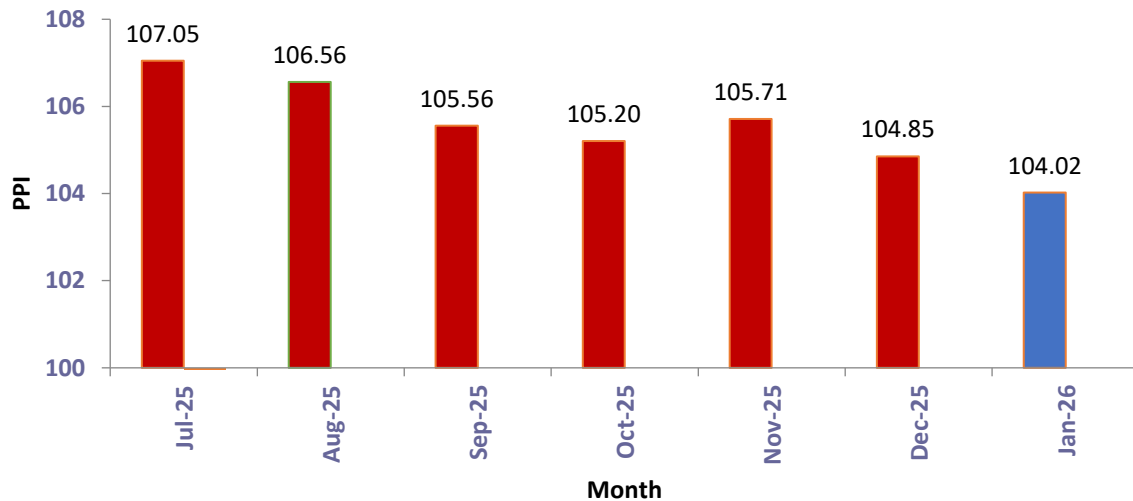

### Department of Statistics: Industrial Producer Prices Decreased by (2.89%) in January 2026

The Department of Statistics (DOS) issued its monthly report on the Producer Price Index (PPI), which observed a decrease by (2.89%) in January 2026 compared to the same period in 2025, and a decline by (0.79%) compared to December 2025.

The PPI of January 2026 had reached 104.02 against 107.12 for the same period in 2025, while the IPI of December 2025 reached 104.85.

On the commodities level, the decrease in the PPI of January 2026 was due to the decrease in the prices of “*Manufacturing Industries*” by (3.51%), with a relative importance of

88.74%, and due to the increases in the prices of “*Quarrying Industries*” by 3.63%, with a relative importance of 5.36% and the prices of “*Electricity*” by 0.82%, with a relative importance of 5.91

Comparing with the PPI of December 2025, it is noted that the decrease of the PPI of January 2026 was due to a (0.97%) decrease in the prices of the “*Manufacturing Industries*”, and due to the incase in the prices of the “*Quarrying Industries*” by 0.41% and the prices of “*Electricity*” by 0.76%.
